## SLYC Parent Code of Conduct (Tennis)

- 1. I am registering my child or children in the SLYC Tennis programs so that they have fun, learn more about tennis, and learn more about being a good team-player.
- 2. I will encourage my child or children to follow the SLYC Participant's Code of Conduct.
- 3. I will respect the instructors and encourage my child or children to respect them.
- 4. I acknowledge that my child or children need to collaborate with other participants in order to create a good on-court experience. I understand that they need to come prepared to play tennis in appropriate attire and footwear, i.e. shorts and T-shirts and tennis or running shoes, and NO swimsuits, sandals or flip-flops.
- 5. I acknowledge that the coaches base their teaching methods on the Long-Term Athlete Development (LTAD) Model. If I have questions about this, I will communicate directly with the Head Pro.
- 6. I will bring my child or children on time for the program, or encourage them to be on time.
- 7. I understand that if my child doesn't follow the participant code of conduct, they can be given a warning, or a time-out, or may have to leave for the class. In extreme or serious situations, or where there is repeated failure to adhere to the Participant's Code of Conduct, they may not be able to return to the program. No refunds will be given in any of these situations. If they have to leave the class and are not picked up promptly, additional charges may be levied if we assign an instructor to care for them while they are waiting to be picked up.
